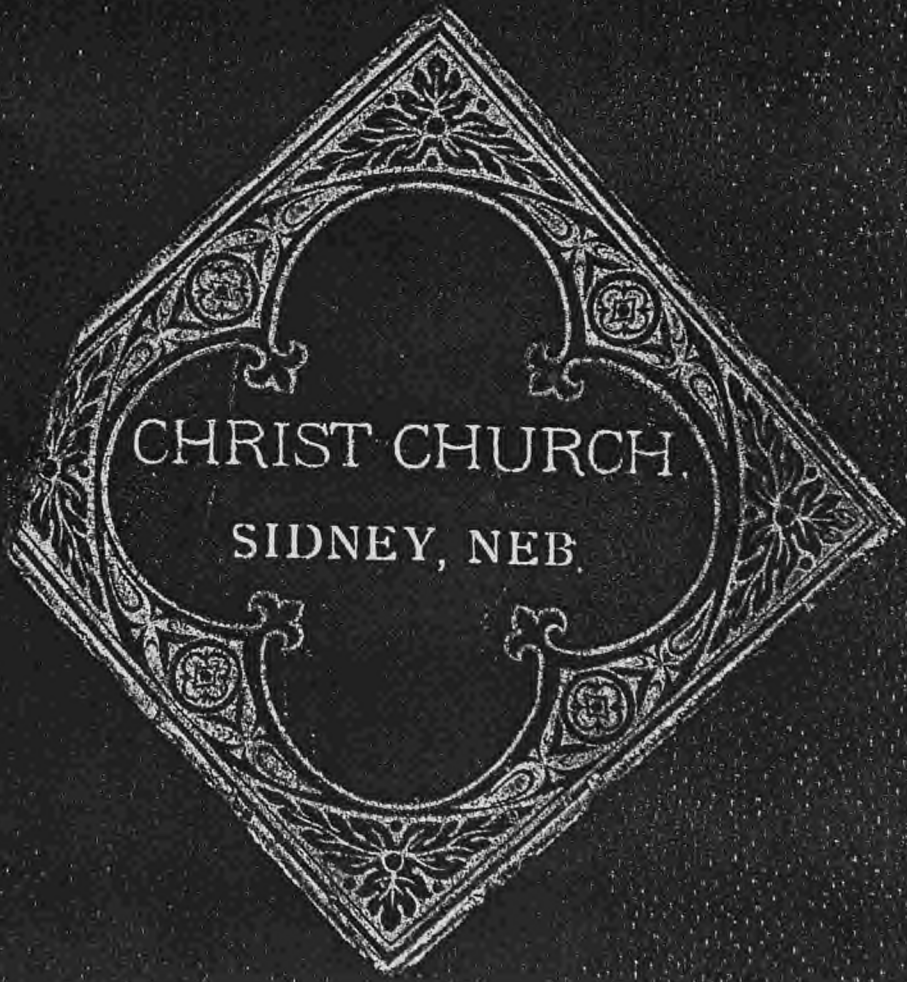

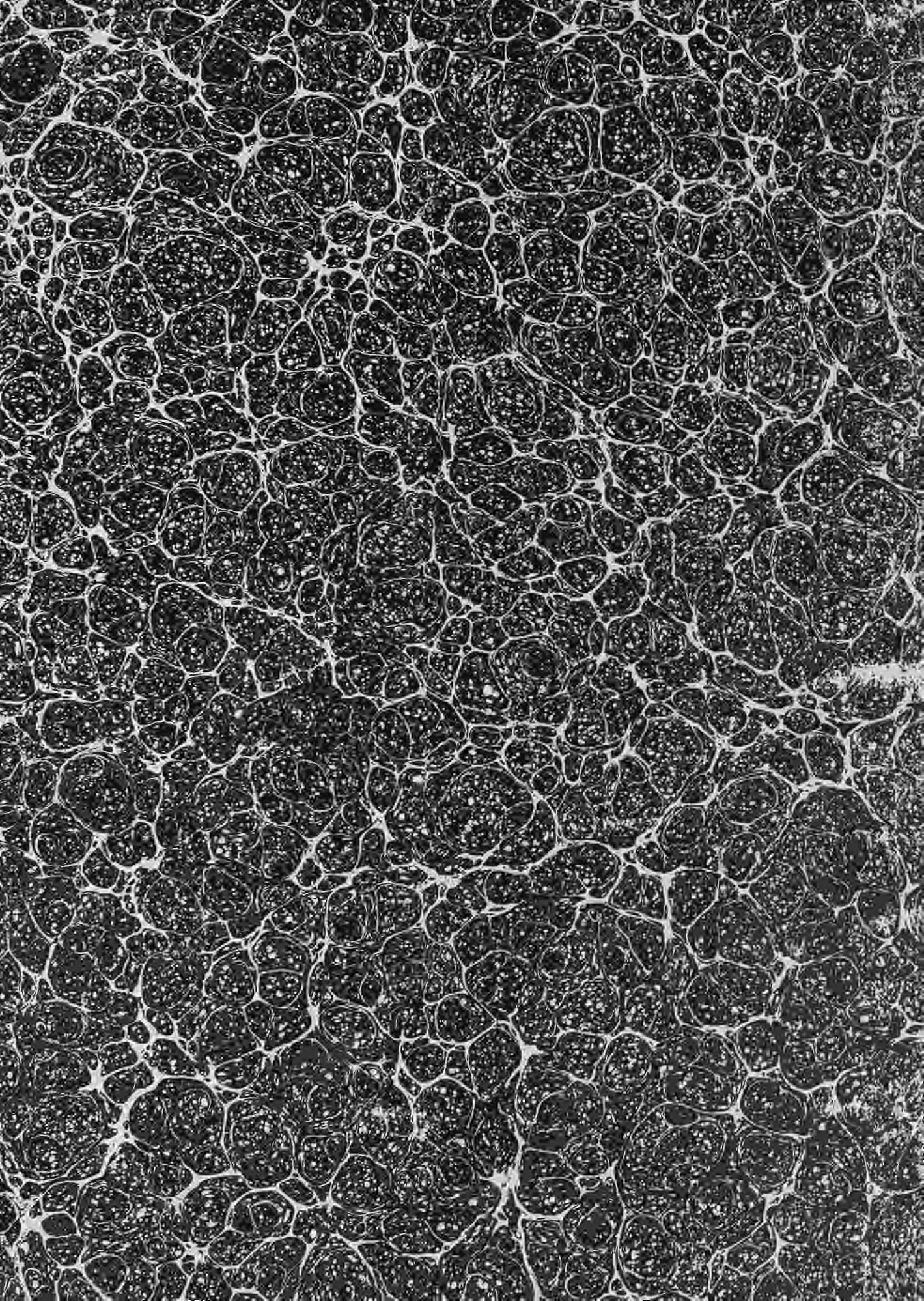

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK.



THE following suggestions and explanations may be of service to clergymen.

I. FACTS:

1. Arrange them in the order in which each family became connected with the parish.
2. Give to each family, less than twelve in number, the space *across the page* between the horizontal red lines; this keeping each family distinct, and leaving room to note subsequent changes. If the family contains twelve or more names, combine two of the horizontal spaces.
3. Write the *ordinal number* I, II, III, IV, etc., under the heading "Number," on the intersection of the double red lines.
4. Insert the maiden name of the wife. Place the names of *children* immediately after those of parents, and other names always in the second column.
5. The age recorded should correspond to the date in the first column.
6. The heading, *S. C. C.*, indicates the abbreviations used respectively for those *baptized, confirmed or communicants*.
7. Deaths may be indicated by the mark (*) immediately before the names; removals by the mark (†).
8. A list of families that kept *will not need re-writing* while the register lasts.

II. BAPTISMS:

1. *Day and Date.* This is *ecclesiastical and civil date*.
2. *Place.* If not in Church, state at what house.
3. In recording adult baptisms, write "adult" under the surname.
4. Give the family name of the mother, the residence of the parents, and the residence and relationship to the child of sponsors other than parents.
5. Every baptism should be authenticated, if possible, by the *signature of the clergyman officiating*.
6. *Gifts/notes of Private Baptisms*, which were not performed in the parish, may be noted on the last line of the page; other considerations, under the "Day and Date," and "Place" of the Private Baptism.

III. COMMUNIONS:

1. Give names in full. *Write the date, if only in the Church.*
2. *Remove.* If in the Church, state the date of removal.

IV. REMOVALS:

1. *Remove.* Write the name, and date, which the name and date should be written.
2. Write the year distinctly above the names added for that year, leaving a blank line above and below it.
3. The narrow column immediately before the name is intended to show at a glance the deaths (*), removals (†), and suspensions or withdrawals (‡).
4. Write the maiden name of married women in a parenthesis *before* the surname; the surname added by marriage after becoming a communicant, in a parenthesis *after* the maiden name; e. g. *Mrs. A—(B—) C— Mrs. A— B—(C—)*. A representing the Christian name, B the maiden name, C the husband's name.
5. *C. A. F.* Denoted by C. those admitted to communion on their contribution to the parish; A, those admitted otherwise, adding C, if subsequently confirmed; B, those removed from another parish. In the latter case, give the name of the parish to which removed.
6. The name of the communicant retaining after removal should, as a general rule, be re-entered at the foot of the list. Except in such cases, no name need be removed, more than once. If the removal is temporary or uncertain, the mark (†) may be in pencil, and thus easily erased.

V. MARRIAGES:

1. "Place": e. g. in Church; or at what house.
2. The names and residence of two or more special witnesses should be recorded.

VI. BURIALS:

1. After the name of a wife, note that of her husband; also that of a child, if one of its parents, etc.

VII. INDEX:

It may often be found convenient to arrange the Index in the form of an *Index Directus*, by dividing the space given to each initial into five subdivisions, heading each with an initial and vowel, the letters representing the first vowel of the name, as *As, An, Al, Ar, Ay, Ac*. The preparation of the index under different initials may be readily found by looking through any alphabetical list in the Church Almanac—or, still better, by first preparing a list from the Parish Records, and registering the spaces accordingly.

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK.

II.—BAPTISMS.

1. *Day and Date*. That is, *ecclesiastical and civil date*.
2. *Place*. If not in Church, state at what house.
3. In recording *adult baptisms*, write "adult" under the surname.
4. Give the family name of the mother, the residence of the parents, and the residence and relationship to the child of sponsors other than parents.
5. Every baptism should be authenticated, if possible, by the *signature* of the clergyman officiating.
6. *Certifications of Private Baptisms*, which were not performed in the parish, may be noted on the last line of the page; other certifications, under the "Day and Date," and "Place" of the Private Baptism.

III.—CONFIRMED.

1. Give names in *full*. Note the *place*, if other than the Church.
2. *Baptism*. If in the parish, a reference (by number or page) to entries of baptisms is sufficient; if elsewhere, give the name of the parish or religious body in which it was performed.

IV.—COMMUNICANTS.

1. "*Day and Date*"—of reception, or first Communion *in the parish*.
2. "*Number*"—as in all cases refers to the chronological order in which the names and date should be written.
3. Write the *year* distinctly above the names added for that year, leaving a blank line above and below it.
4. The narrow column immediately before the name is intended to show at a glance the deaths (*), removals (†), and suspensions or withdrawals (‡).
5. Write the maiden name of married women in a parenthesis *before* the surname; the surname added by marriage after becoming a communicant, in a parenthesis *after* the maiden name: e. g., *Mrs. A—(B—) C—; Miss A—B—(C—)*. *A* representing the Christian name, *B* the maiden name, *C* the husband's name.
6. *C. A. R.* Denoted by *C*, those *admitted* to communion on their confirmation in the parish; *A*, those *admitted* otherwise, adding *C*, if subsequently *confirmed*; *R*, those *received* from another parish. In the latter case, give the name of the parish "whence received."
7. The name of the communicant returning after removal should, as a general rule, be re-entered at the foot of the list. Except in such cases, no name need be recorded more than once. If the removal is temporary or uncertain, the mark (†) may be in pencil, and thus easily erased.

V.—MARRIAGES.

1. "*Place*" i. e. in Church; or at what house.
2. The names and *residence* of two or more special witnesses should be recorded.


VI.—BURIALS.

1. After the name of a wife, note that of her husband; after that of a child, those of its parents, &c.

VII.—INDEX.

It may often be found convenient to arrange the INDEX in the form of an *Index Rerum*, by dividing the space given to each initial into five subdivisions, heading each with an initial and vowel, the latter representing the first vowel of the name, as *La, Ae, Ai, Ao, Auy, &c.* The proportions of the vowels under different initials may be readily found by looking through any alphabetical list—as the Clergy List in the Church Almanac—or, still better, by first preparing a list from the Parish Records, and regulating the spaces accordingly.

PREFACE.

 THE following work grew out of the additions and alterations found necessary in using the ordinary form of Parish Register. It is published at the request of sundry clergymen, by whose suggestions the plan has been much improved. But it is based in great part, as every similar work must be, upon the admirable form of Register published long ago by Messrs. STANFORD & SWORDS; to the author of which the Church is indebted for the first and hitherto the only attempt to provide for the proper collection and preservation of Parochial Records. It is hoped that the improvements made upon that basis, and especially the additional forms contained in this Register, will be considered a sufficient apology for its publication.

The chief objection likely to be made to the plan is the difficulty in large parishes, of always obtaining and recording properly the details for which forms are provided. To this may be answered:

1. Few will doubt that the full registration here provided for is desirable *when* practicable.
2. Such full record will seldom be made, as all experience shows, without the use of tabular forms.
3. A blank space or column, where all the details cannot be obtained, is better than *no* provision for them, where they can and should be recorded.
4. The cases are, after all, rare, where *a little care* on the clergyman's part will not obviate all such difficulty. In the case of persons applying for the baptism of children, a blank form to be filled up by the applicants, or by the clergyman from their answers, will almost always effect the object. In a large parish, such blanks might be printed for Families, Communicants, Marriages, Burials, &c., and accurate details obtained with very little trouble either to rector or people.

In truth, the success and usefulness of this form, or indeed of any form of Parish Register, will depend mainly upon one thing—the willingness of clergymen to bestow as much care upon their Records, and to make their entries with as much fullness, neatness, and accuracy, as is *required* in the accounts of every business, however small and unimportant.

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INTRODUCTION

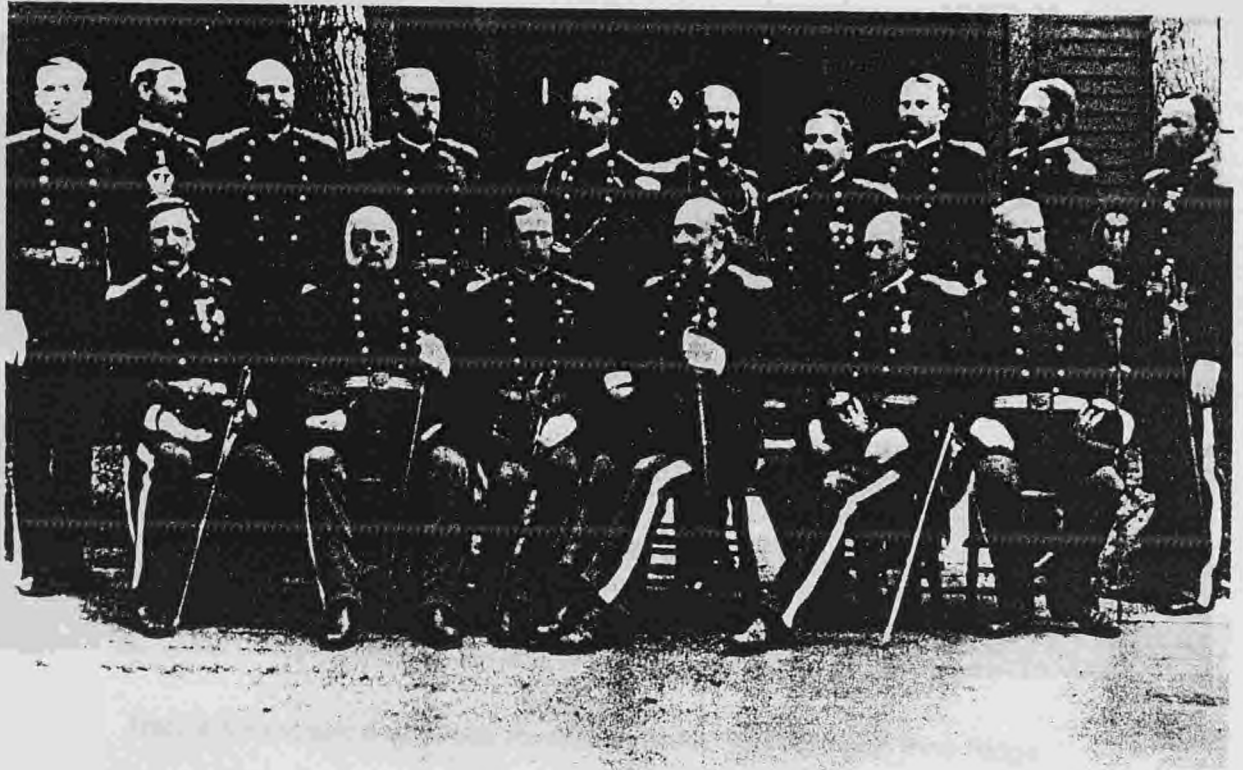
The records of communicants, baptisms, marriages and burials that were recorded by clergy who served historic Christ Episcopal Church between 1886 and 1902 are herein transcribed as accurately as possible given sometimes illegible handwriting and variable spelling of names. The records are of importance to genealogists and church historians for they not only reflect the activity of the Episcopal Church on the western frontier, but also serve as a registry of the military personnel--many of English descent--and Indians assigned duty at the fort, and provide documentation to the whereabouts of early settlers in the Nebraska Panhandle that lies on one of the main crossroads of the Nation.

The records not only include the names, often ages of the recipients of church administrations but, also, their sponsors. Burial records note cause of death and location of internment.

A complete index of the 997 names included in this compilation is arranged alphabetically-- surname, first and middle, and maiden names of married women. Thus prefix designations of "Mrs." and "Miss" are usually added instead of "see also" to assist researchers who may not know a woman's married name.

I wish to thank members of Christ Church Vestry and Father Lyle Martin for granting permission to transcribe the above historic records. Copies are available in the libraries of the Bishop of Nebraska Episcopal Church; Christ Episcopal Church, Cheyenne County, Nebraska; Nebraska State Genealogical; Nebraska State Historical; Daughters of the American Revolution; Lou Spencer of Grand Island, Nebraska and Cheyenne County Genealogical Society.

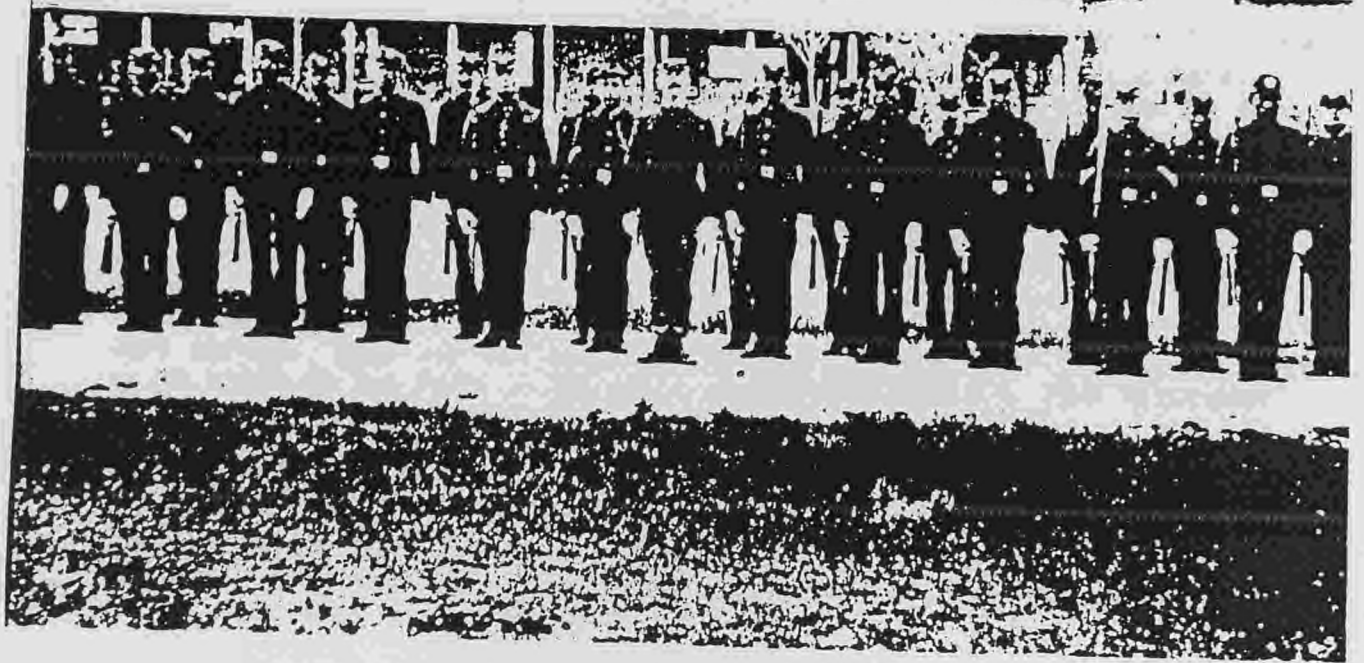

CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH -- MOTHER CHURCH OF THE PANHANDLE #
Sidney, Nebraska

The Episcopal mission movement that generated churches across the western frontier of America began somewhat later than did those of some other churches, but its efforts were a historic first on this high plains region which saw little settlement by the white man until the Civil War brought a need to link East with West by a railroad in a sprawling, fighting new republic caught up in deadly combat.

Those early missionaries were America's heroes in the truest sense of the word for they brought to the unfolding frontier CIVILIZATION. The difficulty of their role was well defined by one of its participants, Bishop Talbot, as he described the scope of his missionary territory as encompassing the present states of Indiana, Missouri, Wisconsin, Iowa and later Kansas, Nebraska and Wyoming. Bishop Talbot called himself "the Bishop-of-All-Outdoors."¹ Another early Episcopal bishop whose domain included present day Texas and Montana when called to build churches, baptize and confirm both red and white men, remarked: "O, for a man who can ride like a cowboy; pray like a saint; preach like an apostle and having some food and raiment, be therewith content."²

Actually, the early history of the Episcopal missionary movement in Sidney town is linked with the military. Sidney town had its beginning with the building of the Union Pacific Railroad and the establishment of Fort Sidney, built by the United States Government to protect railroad workers from hostile Indians.

Several officers at the Fort were Englishmen with religious affiliations in the Anglican Church. They were layreaders and parishiners of Christ Episcopal Church. They were instrumental in bringing members of Company I, Sioux Indians, into Christ Episcopal Church.

The hand of woman also played its part in establishing Christ Episcopal Church. Those officer's wives accepted responsibility in raising money, teaching Sunday School classes and other responsibilities allowed by the Church at the time. An old letter written to her sister from one of these women states the feelings of many women who found themselves cast on the "wild frontier." [Sidney was known as the "wildest town on the line" at that time.] The letter states: "What do you think? We have been to church this morning for the first time in two years!" [An Episcopalian priest from Omaha had conducted services in the schoolhouse.] "I was astonished to see such a good congregation. The clergyman seemed to be a very earnest, good man and gave a plain earnest talk from the text. There is NO PLACE ON THE FACE OF THE EARTH WHERE PREACHING AND TRUE MISSIONARY WORK IS MORE NEEDED THAN HERE."

The Episcopal Church continued to send missionary clergymen and bishops to Sidney. In 1877 Father Gerhard of North Platte instituted Episcopal services every second week -- the first REGULAR services held in the frontier community. Two other Christian denominations likewise began services at that time, Methodist and Catholic.

Early Episcopal services were held in the Masonic Lodge. As recorded: "Some twenty families were estimated as connected with the church and a \$60 a month pledge in support of the clergyman. An organ, prayer books and hymnals and a communion plate have been purchased. A Guild is organized.

"June 11 and 12 a Bazaar was held at the Post Theatre from which \$425 was realized. On August 3, 1886, J. Thomas Clarkson gave the Mission one lot in Sidney -- Lot 6 in Block 25 of the Clarkson Addition. August 19, two lots -- 3 and 4 of Clarkson Addition -- were purchased for \$350 of which sum \$300 was given by Bishop Worthington and \$50 by the Guild. These lots were deeded to the CATHEDRAL CHAPTER OF THE DIOCESE OF NEBRASKA in trust for the use of the Episcopal Church.

"During the rest of the summer subscriptions amounting to \$330 were obtained for the church. Mr. F. M. Ellis, Omaha architect, drew up plans for the building; Mr. Thomas W. Walsh contracted for the stone work at \$317.

"Corner stone of church laid, November 23, 1886 by the Masonic Fraternity and Bishop Worthington consecrated the new church building." 2.

After the church building was consecrated on July 26, 1889, it became the official chapel for Fort Sidney. The vicar was U.S. Army Chaplain Thomas Barry. Vestry president was Captain Ebenezer Stone. Lieutenant Cornman supervised the Sunday School. Most of the Sioux Indian troopers of Company I were confirmed by Bishop Hare. Records state that Army officers, both Indian and White enlisted men, Sidneyites--saved and unsaved--railroad workers and farmers with their families filled the little church building to capacity on that historic July 28, 1889, when Christ Episcopal Church was consecrated.

The historic church -- listed on the NATIONAL REGISTRY OF HISTORICAL BUILDINGS -- has served the community for 118 years and is still in prime condition. A few construction changes have taken place over the years. A narthex and choir loft built from the native field stone once used in the old Cheyenne County Courthouse (razed for a new "Modern" type structure was added on the north side in 1962). A parish hall was added on the east side of the church, instrumented by Father Wright Johnson in 1950. The front entranceway has been changed from the northside to the westside. The quaint bell tower attracts many people's attention as does the tolling on Sunday morning when either the priest or an acolyte ring the bell that hangs there to call people to morning worship and communion. The original bell has disappeared. Dr. Hull Cook replaced it with an antique bell once used in an old Spanish mission in Questa, New Mexico.

Beautiful stained glass windows, given the church as memorials by parishiners and members of Sioux Indian Company I, create an atmosphere of reverence and peace. Specifically the fourth window on the south side is

evidence of our Indian heritage. It is called THE INDIAN WINDOW. The blue and purple lines depict the water and sky. The shades of green depict the Earth's vegetation. The sun and moon shed rays from the top two corners. A cross of gold is superimposed over all God's creation. This window is of historical significance not only for what it states about the Indian's ability to implement Christianity into his or her faith, but because it was given the church by a company of Sioux Indians.

CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, Sidney, Nevada, 1873-1880

September 1873 - The church was held in Sidney by Rev. Dr. Page
Case, from Sept. 1873 to Dec. 1873. A mission was organized, Mr.
Gauglass being pastor & Mr. Page being agent. \$1500. Mr. Case left
occasional services were held by various clergymen. Mr. Clarkson
continued these services for 1874. A choir was organized the same
winter 1873.

From 1874-1875, Rev. Dr. Page held services to March 1875.

The vesting of the church in the hands of the congregation was a visitation
April 1875 & 1876. The church was held by Rev. Dr. Page, who was
baptized in the church. The church was organized by the
congregation, and the following officers were appointed:

Wm. G. Gauglass, Pastor; Wm. G. Gauglass, Treasurer; Andrew J. Haskell,
Clerk; Wm. G. Gauglass, Steward; Wm. G. Gauglass, Supt. of
Singing.

At this visitation, eighteen
families were settled in the church. The church was
planned in the summer of 1875.

The church was held by Rev. Dr. Page, who was
baptized in the church. The church was organized by the
congregation, and the following officers were appointed:

Wm. G. Gauglass, Pastor; Wm. G. Gauglass, Treasurer; Andrew J. Haskell,
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Singing.

HISTORY
CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, Sidney, Nebraska, 1879-1889

September 1879--Services were held in Sidney by Rev. Wm. Page Case, from Sept. 1879 to May, 1880; & a mission was organized, Mr. Douglass being warden & Mrs. Persinger, Clerk. After Mr. Case left, occasional services were held by various clergymen. Bp. Clarkson confirmed seven persons May 2\80, & also visited the place sometime before 1884.

March 1886--Rev. John H. Babcock held services in March /86.

Bsp. Worthington, accompanied by Rev. Babcock, made a visitation April 15th & 16th, 1886; at which time four children were baptised. As no records of the organization could be found, the Bishop organized a Mission, by the name of "CHRIST Mission," & appointed the following officers: Warden, Col. E. W. Stone; Treasurer, Andrew J. Haskell; Clerk, Fred H. D. Castro. Lieut. Dan E. Cornman was appointed Supt of Sunday School; & Col. Stone, lay reader. At this visitation, eighteen persons partook of the Holy Communion; some twenty families were estimated as connected with the church; and \$60 a month pledged in the support of a clergyman. An organ, prayer books & hymnals & a communion plt have been purchased; & the use of a hall for services had been kindly offered by the Masonic Fraternity. A Guild was organized: Mrs. Fred E. H. Ebstein Treasurer, Mrs. Douglass, President, and Mrs. Morgan, Secretary.

March 25th 1886--At the request of the Bishop, Mr. Babcock took chg. of the mission, May 25th, 1886. June 11th & 12th a Bazar was held at the Post Theatre, from which \$425 was realized. July /86. Mr. Haskell resigned, & Robert Henry Douglass was appointed Treasyner. Aug. 3/86, J. Thom. Clarkson gave the Mission one lot in Sidney - Lot No. 6, in Block 25 of Clarkson's Addition. ... Aug. 19/86, two lots - Nos. 3 & 4, in Block 2 of Clarkson's Addition--were purchased for \$350, of which sum \$300 was given by Bp. Worthington, & \$50 by the Guild. These lots & the one given by Mr. Clarkson were deeded to "The Cathedral Chapter of the Diocese of Nebraska," in trust of the use of the Protestant [the word "Protestant" marked through] Episcopal Church. --On Nov. 1886, Mr. Douglass resigned, & Edward M. Mancourt was appointed Treasurer. -- During the summer of all of '86, subscriptions to the amount of \$330. were obtained for a church. Plans for the church were obtained of F. M. Ellis, architect, Omaha; & a contract for the stone work was let to Thos. W. Walsh, for the sum of \$317., Nov. 3/86.

Corner stone of Church laid, 11/23/86. Tues. & Wed., Nov. 23 & 24/86, Bp. Worthington visited the Mission. Tues. P.M. the Corner Stone of the Church was laid, by the Masonic Fraternity & the Bishop; Evg (?) Bp. preached & confirmed two. Wed. am. the Bp. administered H. C.--At a Dolls' Fete & Fair held on the 14th-15th of Dec./86, nearly \$360 was realized for the Building Fund.--Feb. 9/87. a contract was made with A. Pease to finish the church for \$1300.-- Tuesday in Easter Week, April 12th, 1887, the first annual meetings of the Mission & of the Guild were held at the house of Capt. Ebstein.-- May 22/87 after Ascension Day, the church was so far finished that services were held.

The total cost of the building & furniture was about \$1900. Rev. J. H. Babcock resigned his charge, May 25th, 1887.

December 1887--The Rev. Callaghan McCarthy had charge December 1887 to December 1888.

April 1889--The Rev Thomas W. Barry chaplain, U.S.A. had charge from April 1st, 1889 to June 1st. 1891.

September 1890--The Rev. Robert G. Osborn took charge of the Mission Sept 15th 1891;

June 12th 1892--and resigned June 12th 1892 to become Chaplain of the Platte Institute Kearney Neb.

Church Consecrated. 7/28/89. 'Christ' Church was Consecrated by Bishop Worthington, June 28-1889; Presbyter. T. W. Barry being in charge of the Mission.
