hugh beard, b.1847 m. elzina walker, b.1/ /1854. they had five children, susan catherine b.1872,luvina b.1876,martha abigail b.5/25/1879,cleveland b.1884, and lucy, b.d. unknown. they lived in pike county, indiana. about 1887 or88 they traveled by covered wagon to sherman county. my gmother was martha, d.1967. she told of the perilous journey. the rivers they crossed and the constant watch for indians. martha had an eye disorder from birth that left her vision nearly nil. she told of riding in the back of the wagon to keep the light from hurting her eyes. if they were stopped in the day she went under the wagon for the shade. she got partial vision a couple of years later, a deeply religious person, she attributed it only to god and her faith . she could see enough to read her bible for the rest of her life. thefirst year they got to nebraska, it was bitterly cold and snowy (could this have been the great storm of '88)and sence they had no house they took! shelter in a cave. it was so cold that the family had to live in the back of the cave and they hung blankets for a partion and brought their livestock in to keep them from freezing. as i understand ggrandpa dug this cave in the side of a hill. the second year they built a soddy. at one point in their venture, and again i am not sure,but i believe that it was in nebraska they went into a storm shelter when they came out a tornado had taken everything away. while in nebraska another child, maude was born2/ /1889. while there hugh helped build one of the early buildings in litchfield,nebraska near their farm. they eventually returned to their homestate of indiana and raised the family. any info on these people would be appreciated. they are all long gone and i would like to know more to pass down. my mother ,hugh and elzina's favorite ghild is now 91 years old and wants to know about her roots
